> Get educated.

> Let your doctor know that cost is important to you (and so is your healthcare).

Chances are that your doctor isn't thinking about the cost of the procedure, so it's up to you to let your doctor know if your insurance plan does not cover his or her recommendation.

> Discuss choices and alternatives.

Make sure you understand what your treatment involves and what it will or will not do. If your doctor suggests a treatment that you know is going to be expensive, ask if there are other treatments that might work or if less-expensive choices are available. Your doctor can work with you to develop a treatment plan that meets your needs.

> Don't hesitate to ask about cost.

If the costs of your treatment or procedure is too high, your doctor may be able to suggest less-expensive alternatives. If your doctor does not know the cost, ask the office staff or scheduler, or shop around yourself. Visit the savings calculator on Shields.com.
